Justification and Impacts

At TSMAD 25, Australia presented a paper regarding complaints from ECDIS users regarding an overwhelming amount of alarms that were triggered by the numerous restricted areas encoded in ENCs. As a result, S-52 has been modified to lessen the amount of Alerts that the user will see.

However, this table has severely limited the alarms to the use of RESTRN = 14 (area to be avoided). While this alleviates the issue in an S-57 ECDIS, further thought needs to be given as to what the mariner needs to be alerted to regarding the types of restrictions. For example, the RESTRN entry prohibited and entry restricted are not on this list. Many ENC producers would contend that these restrictions should also trigger an alert.

In addition to the Australian paper a separate paper was presented by the United States (NOAA), UKHO and Furuno that looked at adding attributes in S-101 to Restricted Area to eliminate the RESARE03 CSP. The

resulting discussion created the subsequent action that the “DCEG needs to examine the types of RESTRN groupings and consider creating additional RESARE “type” features.

Using the Australian paper as a guide it is proposed to split restricted area into two separate features as a starting point. They are:

1. Restricted Area Navigational – This feature would be to model those restrictions where the ship may have to take a particular action; or the restrictions directly impact on the navigation of the vessel. For example, ATBA’s, Entry Prohibited and Restricted, Speed Restricted, etc.
2. Restricted Area Regulatory – This feature would be to model those restrictions that are regulatory in nature, and do not impact on the navigation of the vessel.

This will also allow for other product specifications to use and extend the regulatory restricted area to encompass items such as particular fishing restrictions and environmental restrictions.

Action Required of S101 Project Team

The S101PT is invited to:

- a. discuss the proposed modelling of Restricted Area
- b. propose any changes to improve the modelling
- c. agree to a final model for testing post DCEG baseline.
