Region H (South Africa)

1) Development and Maintenance of Integrated INT Chart / ENC Schemes

- South Africa is the Region H Coordinator and the designated producer of 44 paper charts in the schema. To date 39 (89%) charts have been produced and published.
- Responsible for the INT chart/ENC schema coverage for South-East Atlantic and South- West Indian Ocean.
- 1: 1000 000 INT SAN charts currently in production:



- Region H consists of a total of 120 charts in the scheme of which 96 (80%) have been produced and published.





2) Allocation of Production Responsibilities, Coordination

- SAIHC ICCWG manage the INT chart/ENC scheme, allocate production responsibilities, and coordinate INT chart/ENC coverage within Region H.



3) Risk Assessment & Nautical Studies, Support and Advice provided in the Region

- No current risk assessment studies

Regional capacity building initiatives. In accordance with the IHO and Southern Africa & Islands Hydrographic Commission (SAIHC) capacity building initiatives, South Africa continues to provide or facilitate training and courses to develop expertise in the SAIHC region, and provide expert advice.

Efforts to assist Mozambique to produce and publish INT charts currently underway.

Captain Abri Kampfer is the current chairman of SAIHC.



4) Existence of a Region H ICCWG, Work by Correspondence, Workload

- SAIHC ICCWG TOR & ROP published on SAIHC site on IHO website.
- 4 meetings of SAIHC ICCWG preceding yearly SAIHC conferences.
- Out of session work done by correspondence.



5) Initial Feedback on Experimental Procedure (IHO CL 64/2015: Revised Management, Review and Monitoring of new INT Charts)

- SANHO agree with the proposed procedure as stated.



6) Lessons Identified, Main Issues, Relevance of Current IHO Standards and Procedures, Recommendations

- Representation by SANHO at NCWG working group meetings not always possible. Correspondence and participation by email.
- Difficulty sourcing survey data from research institutions, Oil and Gas industries and other private sector associations, which may add value in maintaining chart coverage within Region H.
- SAIHC is in full support for the development of a schema for ENCs (INT paper chart schema equivalent)
