Subject: Additional Logistics Information to Section 4 of Annex D to NCWG Letter 01/2017.

Below is additional information regarding travel to Redlands from Los Angeles (LAX) airport. ESRI host's personal preference is the Super Shuttle service because of fatigue after international travel and no transfers. Another option is the Metrolink train, however you will need to transfer to a car or bus at San Bernardino station for the last 15 km to Redlands.

Super Shuttle

Whatever service you choose, it is suggested to select direct route (non-stop). ESRI host's experience with a shared van added 2 hours to her trip.

- Shared-ride van: \$79
- Execucar express \$109

ExecuCar is a sister brand offering a higher-end, private transportation service featuring direct routes to or from the airport. Our reservations system allows for price comparison and booking of both ExecuCar and SuperShuttle.

This private sedan service includes scheduled pickup for up to four passengers, and SUV options are available in many cities for up to six passengers. ExecuCar offers non-airport options, as well, including point-to-point and hourly charters.

Metrolink Train

There is also the MetroLink train (<http://www.metrolinktrains.com/>). \$23 one way and a minimum of 2.5 hours travel time plus several transfers.

- from LAX airport, take the LAX FlyAway Bus to LA union Station Metrolink
- At LA Union Station take the San Bernardino Line to San Bernardino Metrolink station
- Transfer to car transportation for travel to Redlands (15km).
