# Introduction/Background

The 8th meeting of the HSSC took place at the IHB premises, 15 to 18 November 2016. The meeting was attended by 23 member states and 8 organisations which are directly or indirectly affected by HSSC decisions. A meeting of the WG chair persons took place at the IHB, 14 Nov.

## Analysis/Discussion

The main topics were the reports of the HSSC WGs. The committee discussed and endorsed the work done during the last reporting period.

The works of two HSSC WGs, namely the DQWG and the DPSWG, reached a level of maturity that justifies disband of the WGs in 2017. The archived work results will be integrated in the work packages of the affected WGs.

The committee agreed to investigate ways to provide financial support to WGs which need external contributions to complete their work packages.

The MoU between the IHO and the International Cable Protection Committee (ICPC) has been signed. The NIPWG initiative to provide a common text box on cable protection information has been positively recognised.

A work on the visualisation of the certainty of bathymetric data was presented. The proposals can be easily adopted to visualise data quality information of any other products.

The NIPWG application to initiate the development of a ProdSpec on regulatory information was rejected. The committee was the opinion that the development of IHO own ProdSpecs should be in focus.
