Dear Captain,

I am sending to you additional data on the Russian undersea features (Teplov, Zhilinskiy, Gramberg, Kazanskiy, Somov, Yermolenko, as well as Lapushkin, Maksyuta, Nasyr', Gordeyev, Shaposhnikov).

Data on the features with other names (Gnitsevich, Bochkovskiy, Kuz'min, Knizhnik.) will be sent later.

We have plotted additional data on the scheme of Vartan'yan Seamount. We insist on giving the name of Vartan'yan to this seamount. At the same time we (suggest?) the name of Erdman to one of the summits in the Emperor Seamount Chain, which was discovered and surveyed by the Russian research vessels. As additional data we presented a copy of sounding plotting sheet from oceanography vessel "Leonid Sobolev" in 1985. In decision of SCUFN – XVIII, incorrect coordinates of the seamounts are given. - Anashkin Seamount par, 4.2a - correct coordinates: 68°19.0'S, 177°34.0'E - Vartan'yan seamount, 4.2d - correct coordinates: 59°00.8'S, 065°45.0' W.
