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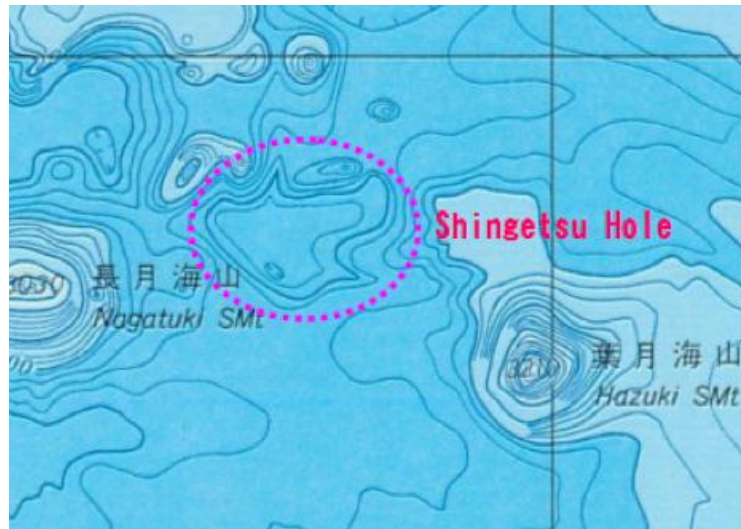


Fig 1. Screen capture of the Japanese chart 6722, showing the location of the Shingetsu Hole.

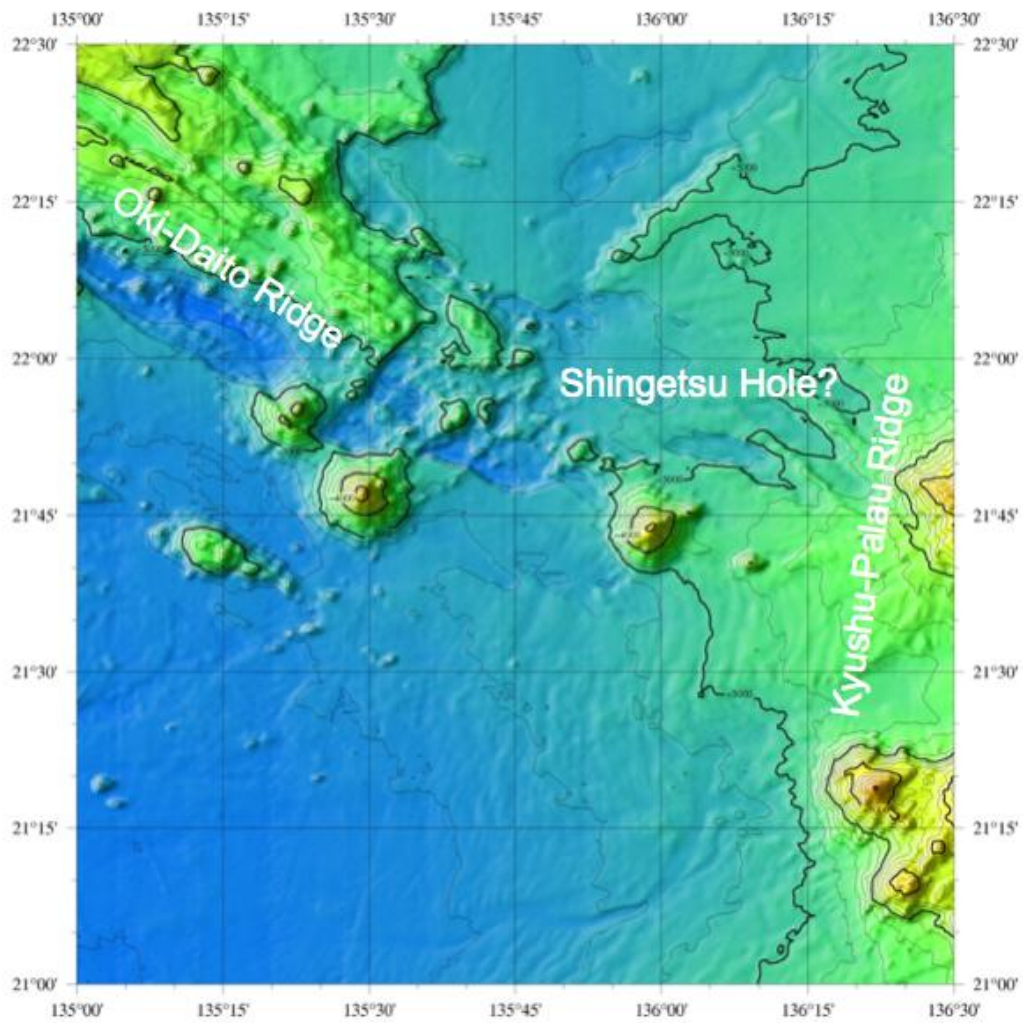


Fig 2. Bathymetric map of the Shingetsu Hole.
