The Canadian Advisory Committee on Undersea Feature Names is pleased to propose 139 existing Canadian undersea feature names to be fast-tracked into the GEBCO Gazetteer database. These already-charted feature names were approved by the Geographical Names Board of Canada and are in the Canadian Gazetteer. All of these features are located inside the Canadian territorial seas, have been in long term use, and have appeared on published charts as far back as 1876.

Attached, hereto, is a list of the names with their spatial component and all references and descriptions. The Shape file contains all the polygons of the 139 features.
