


Fig. 1. Bathymetric map of the Akiko Seamount. Contours are in 100 m.




Fig. 2. Bathymetric map of the Akiko Seamount, shown with track lines. Contours are in 100 m.




Fig. 3. Bathymetric profile across the Akiko Seamount.
