# Analysis/Discussion

The following table summarizes the important recommendations from the S-101 focus group and seeks TSMAD concurrence.

Section		S-101 FG recommendation
1.4	S-101 General Data Product Description	Proposes to change the latitudinal spatial extent from 90 degrees to 88. This will prevent ENC data from crossing the poles.
3	Spatial Resolution	Propose to change the name from Display Scale to Optimum Display Scale.
4.2	Application Schema	Propose to include the S-100 General Feature Model and constrain to only what is needed for S-101.
11.3.1 D	Data Sets	Propose that cells are now called Datasets.
		Propose that the size limit is 10MB.
		Propose to eliminate Re-Issues.
		Propose that datasets can now cross the 180 degree line.
		Propose that CATCOV=2 is eliminated, thus eliminating the need for rectangular datasets. (CATCOV = 1, cannot overlap)
11.3.2	Dataset file naming	Propose the following conventions:
		CCXXXXXXXX.EEE
