Introduction / Background

TSMAD 23, France submitted a paper to conduct an S-101 Impact Study in accordance to IHO Resolution 2/2007. This paper outlined the propose methodology and TSMAD 23 agreed to the methodology and that France would lead a small group to formulate the survey. This group, included Canada, United Kingdom, United States and Jeppessen.

Analysis/Discussion

During the time between TSMAD 23 and TSMAD 24, a draft survey was prepared and the resulting survey is presented in Annex A along with an updated S-101 Information Paper in Annex B.

Conclusions

This survey asks specific questions for each type of stakeholder to determine what impacts that S-101 may have on the user community as a whole. Once TSMAD/DIPWG has approved the survey content, the questions will be put into a web-based survey for distribution and the results will be presented at HSSC4 and TSMAD 25.
