Dear Mr. Chairman.

Greece appreciates the work done by the WENDWG concerning the proposed changes to the Guidelines for the Implementation of the WEND Principles.

After consideration of the proposed texts Greece would like to reiterate its position that has been initially expressed during the 11<sup>th</sup> WEND meeting (Tokyo 2008), according to which the end-user service providers (RENCs or individuals) do not have the legitimacy to eliminate or amend ENCs. This right and responsibility belongs exclusively to the producing governmental organization.

Following the above, Greece proposes the amendment of the Guidelines and the Amplifying Annex as follows:

- a. In paragraph 1.7. of the Guidelines the sentence "In situations where overlapping ....... is satisfactory addressed" to be deleted.
- b. In paragraph B.b of the Amplifying Annex the sub-paragraph 2 to be deleted and the sub-paragraph 1 to be merged with the main body of the paragraph.
- c. Paragraph B.d to be deleted.
