# What is a RENC?

A RENC is an organisation that assists HOs in the production, quality assurance and distribution of ENCs. There are currently two RENCs, IC-ENC and PRIMAR. Both deliver ENC services to their members using similar operating models, however, differences do exist. These differences allow ENC Producers intending to join a RENC to choose the operating model and service to best suit their national needs.

# What are the benefits of RENC membership?

### **Data Quality:**

IC-ENC and PRIMAR have established and refined quality assurance services in order to ensure ENC quality, consistency and harmonization, benefiting ENC users. Co-ordination and sharing of ENC knowledge and experience among member HOs avoids duplication of work and ensures efficiency.

### **ENC** Distribution:

ENCs distributed through IC-ENC and PRIMAR are available to the end users through a wide range of service providers, under harmonized terms and conditions. This drives high levels of customer service and innovation by the service providers, benefiting ENC users.

#### **Revenue Management:**

IC-ENC and PRIMAR provide detailed sales reports for each member, and manage the collection of revenue from Value Added Resellers/Distributors, returning the appropriate amount to the HO.

### Other HO services:

IC-ENC and PRIMAR offer other services for HOs, as defined by their operating models, and as set by their members. Such activities include training, workshops, and bespoke technical support.
