Dear Hydrographer,

- 1. The Directing Committee thanks the following Member States that replied to CCL 3 (Reference A) concerning the preparation of the lists of Observers to be invited to the 1st Session of the IHO Assembly (A-1): Bangladesh (BD), Chile (CL), Colombia (CO), Ecuador (EC), Iran (Islamic Republic of IR), Japan (JP), Netherlands (NL), United Kingdom (UK).
- 2. Based on the responses received, the Directing Committee has drawn up the proposed lists of Observer States and Organizations to be invited to A-1. Those lists are now submitted for approval or comment, as required by Article 4 of the new General Regulations (Reference B) that will be in force at the time of the Assembly, and in accordance with the revised timeline for the preparation of the session (Reference C).
- 3. In relation to invitations for States that are not Parties to the IHO Convention, paragraph (a) of Reference B specifies "one or two observers each, if proposed by a Member State, the Council or the Secretary-General and subject to approval by two thirds of the Member States". In the absence of any comment on the proposed list circulated with Reference A, the Directing Committee proposes that the Secretary-General invite all States listed in Table 1 of Annex A, subject to the required approval of Member States. Member States should note that a two-thirds majority of IHO Member States is required.
- 4. In accordance with paragraph (b) of Reference B, the Secretary-General will invite Member States with rights suspended that are listed in Table 2 of Annex A.
- 5. In accordance with paragraphs (c) and (d) of Reference B, but subject to any further comment from Member States, the Secretary General will invite those intergovernmental organizations and non-governmental international organizations listed in Tables 1 and 2 of Annex B.

- 6. With regard to the list of other organizations that could be invited, as indicated in paragraph 5 of Reference A, the Secretary-General will invite those organizations that have been specifically proposed by Member States. Those organizations are listed in Annex C. If there are no further proposals or comments from Member States regarding the list in Annex C, only those organizations listed in Annex C will be invited.
- 7. Member States are now requested to consider approving the list in Table 1 of Annex A and to provide any further comments they may have on the lists in Annexes B and C, using the Response Form, provided in Annex D.
- 8. Member States are reminded that a two thirds majority approval is required to invite those States not Parties to the IHO Convention presented in Annex A. Responses are requested **no later than 21 October 2016**.
