
The Arctic Region Hydrographic Commission 1st Conference

A Mariners Routing Guide for the Arctic.

- The idea is to provide mariners with an easy to use guide which allows users to instantly access necessary information
- The Guide should provide essential information for safe navigation in the Arctic region.
- The Guide should include information on reporting systems, ice conditions, maritime assistance services, special regulations, coverage of paper charts and ENC, as well as water levels and land rise.
- The Guide should supplement the nautical chart portfolio for the area.
- Provide a printed version
- The possibility for a web version of the Guide should be investigated

Establishing an Arctic Publication Working Group ARHCPWG

The ARHC 1st Conference is requested to consider this proposal and to take appropriate actions

The Working Group should (DRAFT):

- Identify and analyse the current status of maritime publications in the Arctic.
- Analyse how Arctic Hydrographic Offices can contribute their information and the necessary updates, so information can easily be used by the mariners.
- Focus on how ARHC in the future can benefit from a regional approach.
- Monitor the development of publications that could be relevant for the Arctic.
- To present a report to the ARHC. This report should include a description on the current status, recommendations on how to proceed with the publications and if deemed necessary an action plan with specified time schedule for future ARHC actions.
