BSHC 18th Conference Tallinn, Estonia September 2013

Establishment of a proprietary BSHC internet domain

1. Initial setup of www.bshc.pro

BSHC17 tasked DE and SE under Action item #6 to cooperate in establishing a pilot BSHC webpage and suggest a sustainable maintenance regime/concept to BSHC18.

Germany and Sweden have now commonly installed a graphical layout and a structure of BSHC items to be presented externally as services or information about past, present and future BSHC activities under www.bshc.pro.

2. Future maintenance regime

Pending general acceptance of the Commission of the draft layout and structure of <u>www.bshc.pro</u>, Germany and Sweden are proposing to concentrate the technical hosting and the maintenance of the internet domain under one member state.

With regard to the management of the content the following procedure is proposed:

- The general arrangements of graphical layout and structures are subject to adoption of the BSHC. Minor changes of the layout need no further approval.
- Addition and/or deletion of content presented under <u>www.bshc.pro</u> in between BSHC conferences require confirmation by the BSHC-Chair. The BSHC-Chair will let forward such content to the technical host or the technical host will contact the chair if he receives content desired to be published under the BSHC domain.
- Revision of the work performed by the technical host and the content of the BSHC domain becomes a standing agenda item for the BSHC-Conferences. It is then up to the Conference to decide about all aspects of BSHC domain maintenance including technical facilitation and modifications of content.
- It is agreed as a general rule, that content affecting BSHC but already made available by other domains, is not duplicated under the BSHC domain. Instead, direct links leading to the external source are the preferred arrangement.

The Commission is invited to

- take note of the report;
- comment on the presented draft arrangements of www.bshc.pro;
- discuss the proposed maintenance regime;
- propose further content to be published under BSHC domain;
- propose further organisations to enter under the "Relations" tab.
