BSHC 18th Conference 16-18 September 2013, Tallinn

The BSHC 18th Conference will take place on 16-18 September 2013. The previous meeting in Tallinn (BSHC 9th Meeting) took place more than decade ago and most of today delegates haven't participated in it. Thus we suggest, next to the official programme to see Tallinn. For those who are here first time to see some of the most interesting places and those who haven't recently been to Tallinn to see how much the town has changed. A guided tour to Old Town (under UNESCO protection) will take place on 16th September. At the Icebreaking Party in the recently renovated TV Tower of Tallinn you will enjoy a bird's eye view of the city.

On Tuesday during the technical tour we will visit a famous Seaplane Harbour of the Estonian Maritime Museum. The Seaplane Hangar is the unique construction of the kind in the world. It is the most visited museum in Estonia at present.

As to accommodation we have preliminarily reserved rooms for 25 persons in the Sokos Hotel Viru in Tallinn, on favourable conditions. For registration via internet (<u>www.sokoshotels.ee</u>) use reservation code: BSHC18. This guarantees your room on your arrival date. Your credit card will not be charged in advance. The Sokos Hotel Viru is situated in the very centre of Tallinn (4 Viru Square) and everything is at hand (Old Town, shopping centres etc). The airport is ca 10 minutes drive away by taxi (fare ca $8 \oplus$ and bus No 2 is also available (fare 1.60 \notin stop opposite the hotel).

The BSHC 18th Conference will take place in the VTS Centre of the Estonian Maritime Administration (Valge Str 3). Transfer will be provided.
