World Hydrography Day

Hydrography – supporting the blue economy

- Required:
 - <u>Positive</u> economic arguments
 - High-tech photographs and images



World Hydrography Day

Positive economic arguments :

- For most ships, 30cm extra depth allows at least 2,000 tonnes more cargo to be carried
- Passengers from a typical modern cruise ship spend over a quarter of a million dollars in port every day
- 1 hour saved on a sea passage is \$500 \$1500 less fuel for a large container ship

- Directorate-General for Maritime Affairs and Fisheries (DG Mare)
- CL 97/2002
 - First meeting October 2012
 - Discussion of hydro related EU activities and projects
 - Mexico suggestion that maritime areas of interest to European shipping outside the EU should be considered was acknowledged
