Key challenges

- 1. Resources:
 - MS and industry fully committed to day jobs
 - No funding currently in place to establish technology
 - Has affected our communication
- 2. Skill sets:
 - Donor funding (outside IHO CB) knowledge lacking within this specialised group
- 3. Duplication/gaps (efficiency):
 - Need to avoid duplication with other IHO/RHCs activity
 - Need to avoid gaps





Next Steps

- Engage with SMEs from other HCs to collaborate
- MEIP MS to complete "questionnaire"
- Create online evaluation tool for MACHC to review
- MEIP-WG to consider maritime funding actions:
 - To develop a platform of what projects to feed
