Letter to MACHC offering Belém as headquarters for the meeting in 2016.

Dear Chairman,

1. Location.

The reason for this letter is the offer of the Brazilian Hydrographic Office (DHN) to host the MACHC meeting to be held in 2016, in the City of Belem, at the Delta of the Amazon River. Situated at the Delta of the Amazon River and in the very south of the cartographic area covered by MACHC, the Belém City is within both maritime and fluvial environment and in a challenging hydrografic region, due to the peculiar amplitude of the tides, strong currents, constant variation of depths and dense forests associated with predominately no land elevations in the region.

Belém, with his 1.5 millions inhabitants, is the headquartered Command of the 4th Naval District, who has under its subordination the Center of Survey and Nautical Signaling of the Eastern Amazon (CLSAOR), DHN's operational arm in Eastern Amazon. The CLSAOR is encharged of three hydrographic ships, 2 of them newly built specifically to operate in rivers, and one buoy tender vessel, as well as boat specifically tailored to surveys in the region. Furthermore, the 4th DN has also under his subordination the Belém Naval Base, the Patrol Ships Group, a Naval Hospital, a Centre of Merchant Marine Officer Training and the Port Authority of Eastern Amazonia. Due to the geographical features of the region and the logistics facilities already offered by 4°DN Command, we understand that Belém would be the ideal place

for the holding in 2016 of a meeting of MACHC which, if approved by the Fore, could be composed of a Seminar for the exchange of information between private and public entities, local and Caribbean region, involved in Safety of Navigation and/or Raising Awareness of Hydrography; Survey training/demonstration on board for students and/or trainees of the Caribbean region as well as local; and the Plenary Meeting itself.

Also it is worth mentioning that in 2016, Belém celebrates its 400th anniversary and the city's mayor has participated to the Commander of 4DN his support to the event, as can be seen in the attached letter addressed to this chairman. Below follow a program, a suggestion of chronology for the event, which can be changed according to the needs of this committee, as well as logistics information and facilities now available.

2. Programming.

The facilities and means available allow us to devise the event, as a whole, consists of:

a) A seminar on "Conscientiouness of the Importance of Hydrography", lasting two or three days, with simultaneous translation, with the audience of local and foreign companies involved in shipping, academia and opinion makers. In this seminar, there will be presentations of IHO, Brazilian Hydrographic Office, Professor of Brazilian University and other local institutions. It will also be open to submissions from private or state-owned enterprises involved in navigation, or any other Stake Holders. There will also be available one contiguous space for the exhibition of equipment and work affects the subject, during the seminar.



- b) exhibition of hydrographic equipment by the invited companies, on board of boats made available by the Navy, in river area in front of the Naval Base pier (located about 40 minutes from the city center);
- c) the possibility of adding, to the exhibition, a training/demonstration to potential participants invited by the IHO \ MACHC; and

d) MACHC Meeting:

the auditorium will be equipped with simultaneous translation English\Spanish and WI-FI, over the five days.

3. Suggested chronology.

30 November to 4 December: arrival of the delegations;

1 and 2 December: Seminar;

3 and 4 December, Saturday and Sunday: free:

5 and 6 December: training:

5 to 9 December: Meeting MACHC.

4. Available facilities.

To date, the following facilities are ensured at no cost to the IHO or to the delegates:

- availability of accommodation and meals for participants from the Caribbean region invited by the IHO;
 - transport between the hosting sites and events;
 - transportation of delegates and participants between the airport and place of

accommodation and vice-versa.

- two cocktails as Gathering to be hosted one by the Navy and one by Navy Local League.

Other Information.

a) Available flights:

There is availability of flights, direct, from Miami to Belém, as well as from Cayenne and Paramaribo to Belém. There are also the availability of daily flights from/to Belém with a stopover in Manaus.

b) Hosting:

The average prices of the various 4-star hotels in Belém, ranging today between US\$ 80.00 and 120.00, including breakfast. Most hotels are located downtown.

c) Weekend.

Once there is a weekend included during the events, a boat trip to the islands nearby Belém (lunch included) can be programmed. This tour will be in charge of each representative and will be organized by the host, with the approximate cost of US\$ 50.00.

For the weekend various options of visits to tourist sites, restaurants, bars, beaches, museums and tours will be available for the representatives.

Presentation.

If the Chairman deems appropriate, the Brazilian delegation will be available to give a presentation about the event at the end of the agenda of the 16th meeting of MACHC, to be held in St John on December.
