- Approval of the Protocol of Amendments to the IHO Convention
  - 39 approvals / 48 (ref. 2005)
  - All NHC Member States have approved the Protocol
- Awaiting accession
  - Bulgaria (1992)
  - Haiti (2012)
  - Mauritania (1991)
  - Montenegro (2012)
  - Sierra Leone (2010)

- Brunei Darussalam (2012) : 30/52 (DK, FI, IS, NO, SE)

# ENC issues

## ■ IHO ENC Catalogue

- Responses to CL No 51/2012: DK, FI, IS, NO, SE
- 24 positive responses as of 1<sup>st</sup> April 2013
- IHB priority: ensure that the IHO ENC Catalogue, referenced in IMO circulars on ECDIS, is fully operational and easily maintainable  
=> Action in progress in liaison with Primar and IC-ENC  
(to be reported to 3<sup>rd</sup> WEND WG meeting)

- Development of a new framework
