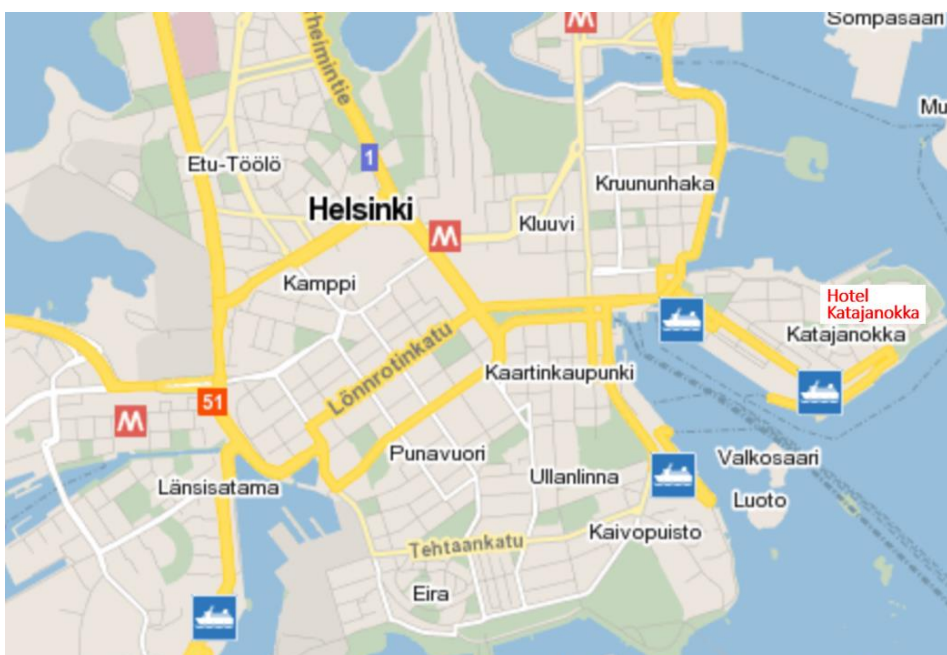

Getting from Helsinki-Vantaa Airport to Katajanokka

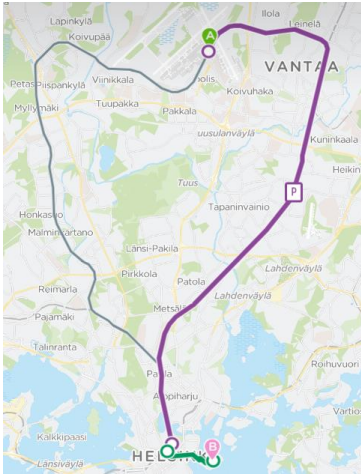
Helsinki-Vantaa Airport is situated about 20 km north of Helsinki City Centre. You can use both public transportation or taxis to get Hotel Katajanokka.










Train+Tram

Example:



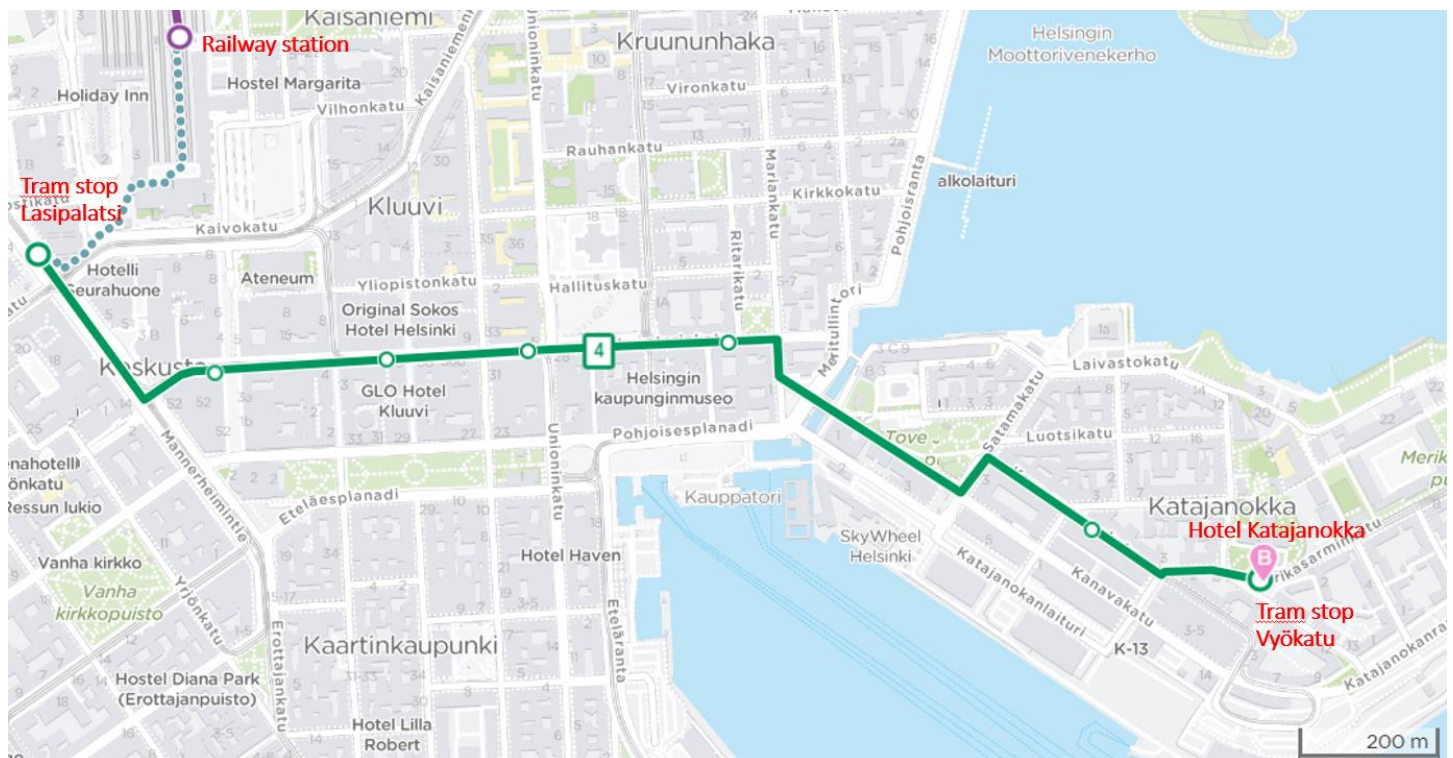
- 12:00  Airport, Lentokenttä, Vantaa

Train P Helsinki
10 stops (28 min)
- 12:30  Helsinki 0070
-  Walk 500 m (6 min)
- 12:36  Lasipalatsi 0102
-  Wait (5 min)
- 12:42  Lasipalatsi 0102 Platform 52
Tram 4 Katajanokka
5 stops (10 min)
- 12:52  Vyökatu

Total distance: 25 km

At the Airport, Railway station is located between Terminal 1 and Terminal 2. Follow the signs. There are two trains (I and P) which both operates between Airport and Helsinki main railway station. Different route, but almost same travel time. Train to Main Railway Station takes about 35 mins and costs 5 euros. You can buy tickets from ticket machines (not from train).

From the Helsinki main railway station you can continue (with same ticket) by Tram (Tram number 4, direction Katajanokka).

Taxi

Travel by taxi takes about 35 minutes. Cost approximately 50-60 €. Due to the new taxi regulations in Finland, it is good to ask the driver in advance for the price.
