Agenda item 15, ENC coverage – explanatory note

15.1 - Status report on ENC coverage in the region

The UKHO has provided two graphics (see Annex A) showing gaps in ENC Band 2 and Band 3 in the NIOHC region, in order for NIOHC to fully support the IRCC tasking of the WEND-WG to:

- 1. Monitor progress in providing ENC coverage and identify and propose solutions to issues of concern such as gaps and overlaps.
- 2. Investigate and report on the significance of other areas of concern:
 - a. variation in licensing terms and conditions
 - b. reports of ENC quality and updating issues
- 3. Provide support to IHB in preparation of reports to IMO NAV Sub-Committee (June 2011)

There are several causes of gaps and overlaps in ENC coverage, such as: <u>Gaps</u>

- 1. Accidental
- 2. Incorrect banding
- 3. No national chart of area
- 4. No INT chart of area
- 5. ENC not issued but planned for production

<u>Overlaps</u>

- 1. Accidental
- 2. Incorrect banding
- 3. Desire to have complete national coverage of waters that directly affect the nation state
- 4. Desire to have small scale coverage of areas of interest

The NIOHC chair would appreciate member states to comment on the adequacy of the ENC coverage in their waters; prior or during the meeting.
