The purpose of the ENC workshop is to look at the current ENC coverage of the region and assess the following:

- 1. Agreement of NIOHC region ENC scheme for Bands 3, 4, 5 and 6.
- 2. Reduction of overlaps within cells
- 3. Reduction of gaps in coverage within usage band 3
- 4. Analysis of coverage for emerging ports
- 5. EPNM's: their implications and outstanding items in NIOHC region. These will be sent individually to nations and if not resolved prior to meeting can be discussed here.
- 6. WEND-WG correspondence and feedback of coverage status to chair
- 7. Discussion on the adoption of HSSC proposal (Action HSSC1/24) for NIOHC Paper INT Charting coordinator to take on the NIOHC ENC coordinator role and rename as the North Indian Ocean International Charting Coordination Working Group (NIOICCWG)

Proposed outcomes:

- 1. Report to NIOHC Plenary
- 2. Report to WEND-WG Chair on status of ENC's within the NIOHC region for them to include in their report to IRCC4.
