What is the weather like?

The temperature during mid-July in Cairo ranges between 32° to 42°C with a mostly clear sky. The humidity typically ranges between 40 to 60%. The average wind speed is usually calm to moderate breeze.

What electricity supply is used?

In Egypt the standard voltage is 220 V. The standard frequency is 50 Hz. The power sockets that are used are of type C / D / G / K. Your need for an adapter or converter depends on the voltage, frequency and power plugs in the country you live in.
