Getting from Dublin Airport to City Centre

Dublin Airport is situated 10km north of Dublin City Centre and is approx. a 25 minute drive from the city centre. It is served by a large number of buses and taxis all allowing you to get to and from the airport with ease.

Taxi from Dublin Airport to City Centre

Taxis are available from the forecourts directly outside Terminal 1 and Terminal 2. Passengers should follow Taxi signage to the designated taxi ranks. A taxi dispatcher is available at either taxi rank if you require any further information or assistance. A taxi from the airport to city centre costs approx. $\in 30$.

Buses from Dublin Airport

There are a number of bus options for passengers travelling by bus to the city centre. Passengers should follow the signs for the relevant zone from Terminal 1 or Terminal 2.

Airlink 747 is a quick way to travel between Dublin Airport and City Centre. This bus will only stop at dedicated Airlink bus stops. The nearest stop to the meeting venue is Stop 9 at Trinity College. Fares cost €6 single; €10 return. Tickets can be purchased at the following points in the airport: Terminal 1 Terminal 2 Bus and Rail Information Desk, Arrivals Hall. Spar Shop Vending machines located at the Airlink Bus Stop. Spar Shop or online.
