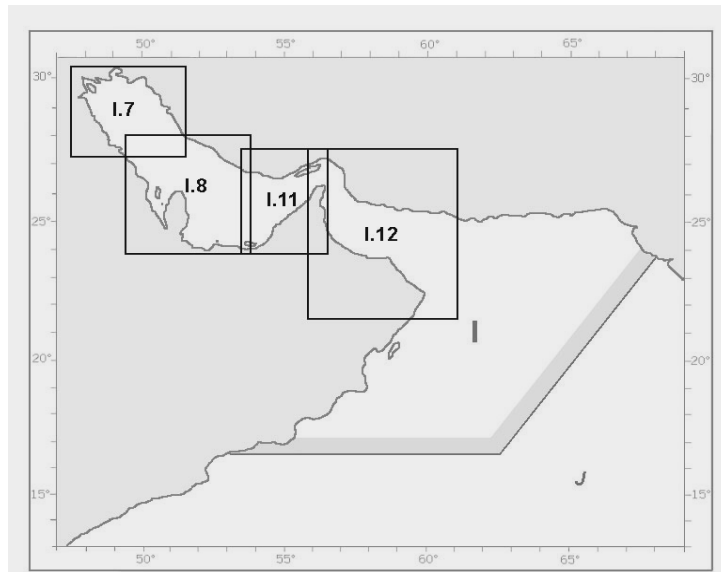


Coordinator's Report on INT Chart Scheme in Region (I).

The aim of the international chart is to facilitate the provision of minimum sets of charts suitable for the navigational requirements of international (foreign-going) shipping. According to INT Chart Scheme In total, there are 106 International charts in different scales within the Region (I). These charts are assigned among seven regional countries together with United Kingdom .States within the INT chart Region (I) are as follow:

Bahrain, Iran, Kuwait, Oman, Pakistan, Qatar, Saudi Arabia and United Arab Emirates.



Limits of Region (I) International Chart Scheme

These six countries have been assigned INT charts and have produced INT charts according to the INT Scheme in region (I) as follows:

1. Bahrain

Conclusions

Effective INT charts are required well cooperation between regional states. Production and Printing an INT chart based on M-4 (Regulations of the International Charts) is essential, particularly providing Repromat. To achieve defined standards in different IHO documents, formal arrangement between Regional States (bilateral or multilateral arrangements) according to guidelines provided in IHO CL 48/1995 is fundamental.

It is very important to follow M-4 section 500 (exchange of reproduction material), when reproducing new charts editions.

It is believed that IHO can play very important role to encourage regional States to cooperate to produce INT charts to preparing an arrangement (or procedure) by IHO, could make a potential enhancement to further cooperation between the MS.

(Availability of similar arrangements or procedure in other RHCs can be used).
