



- Contribution to the work of the United Nations Development Group and the UNDG Working Group in the development of specific performance indicators against which will be determined the success of maritime technical assistance activities.
- Priority to meeting the special assistance needs of Africa, Least Developed Countries (LDCs) and Small Island Developing States, and empowering women as key maritime resources.
- Integration of IMO's regulatory priorities into the programme-building process

- delivery of technical assistance through knowledge-sharing; technical advisory services; and maritime training events
- delivery of ITCP activities through modern and digital technology
- mobilization of regional expertise and resources for technical assistance activities
- coordination with other development aid programmes in the maritime sector
- Application of monitoring and evaluation systems to measure the effectiveness of the ITCP








