USCHC MEETING 20 MARCH 2017 INVITATION AND LOGISTICS INFORMATION GALVESTON, TEXAS USA

Dear Colleagues,

1. The fortieth meeting of the United States-Canada Hydrographic Commission (USCHC) will take place on 20 March2017 in Galveston, TX at the Moody Gardens Hotel. The USCHC meeting is scheduled a day before the opening ceremonies of the US Hydro 2017 conference hosted by The Hydrographic Society of America (THSOA). The USCHC meeting will take place from 09:00 to 17:00 in the same venue as the conference.

It is not necessary that participants to the USCHC meeting attend the US Hydro conference.

The hotel offers complimentary wireless internet access in all guest rooms and meeting rooms. Self-parking is complimentary; valet parking is \$20.00 for overnight. Check in is at 4:00 p.m. and check out is at 12:00 p.m.

ANNEX B

TRANSPORTATION AND AIRPORT

Travelers should schedule transportation to and from the venue in advance. The hotel does offer group shuttle service to the airport if scheduled well in ahead of time.

The closest airport to the venue is the William P. Hobby Airport (airport code: HOU). The airport is located approximately 41 miles (66 km) from the venue. For travelers flying into the William P. Hobby Airport, the use of the **airport shuttle** to Galveston, TX is **NOT** recommended. This shuttle will take you to the cruise ship terminals, 4.4 miles (7 km) from the venue.

An alternative airport in the Houston area is the George Bush Intercontinental Airport (airport code: IAH). The airport is located approximately 70 miles (113 km) from the venue.

Although the George Bush Intercotinental Airport is further away, there may be viable scheduling and cost options for flights depending on your individual travel plans.
